

# IAP2 Remote Engagement Essentials Training Workshop



The IAP2 Remote Engagement Essentials is a 2 day training workshop designed for anyone who needs to plan and deliver stakeholder and community engagement according to internationally accepted foundations and standards.

## Engagement Essentials and Practice Integration

This starter module provides participants with an overview of the five essential components underpinning effective engagement. Participants will have a practical opportunity to unpack the definition of engagement, the contemporary model of engagement, stakeholder analysis, setting engagement goals and considering what level of participation is appropriate for the stakeholders and communities. Using live projects from the participants, this is a 'hands on' course to kick start effective engagement planning.

This workshop is designed to apply the frameworks for effective engagement practice and making it real in a Northern Territory context. Focusing on remote engagement, this includes practical applications for intercultural experiences and skill development in working with the Aboriginal Interpreter Service and hearing the challenges by not utilising first language. A panel session involving guest speakers helps participants to understand and work with the complexities of remote engagement work across the Territory.
